# PENNSYLVANIA HIGH SCHOOL SPEECH LEAGUE

## EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING – MARCH 24, 2011

### CALL TO ORDER

The Executive Board of the Pennsylvania High School Speech League was called to order at 1:00 PM, on Thursday, March 24 in Meeting Room 2, Degenstein Campus Center, Susquehanna University with the following members present: Lisa Bompiani-Smith, Keith Brosious, John Buettler, Stacey Cawley, Barbara Giuliano, David Long, Michael Nailor, Kate O'Halloran, William Murray, Hugh Ringer, Alice Ursin, Beth Young, Larry Augustine, Executive Director, and Carolyn Trotta, Secretary. Excused from the meeting were Neil Strine and Reed Messmore.

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the June 26, 2010, meeting were approved. Motion: Ms. Ursin. Second: Ms. Bompiani-Smith.

### ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Mr. Augustine welcomed everyone to the meeting and reminded board members that the agenda for this meeting is designed to handle State Tournament matters and not general PHSSL items.
2. Mr. Augustine gave everyone tournament programs and telephone numbers for the meeting room, chapel foyer for registration, and the tab rooms for the weekend.
3. Mr. Augustine made an announcement that Persuasive Speaking was being moved from the Elementary School to the High School due to space availability.
4. Mr. Augustine announced that the terms of Ms. Bompiani-Smith, Mr. William Murray, Ms. Kathleen O'Halloran, and Ms. Beth Young expire at the end of the 2010-2011 fiscal year. All four board members agreed to run for another term. An announcement will be made during the Friday opening meeting that anyone interested in running or anyone wishing to nominate someone to the Board for a 3-year term should let Ms. Alice Ursin, Ms. Stacey Cawley, Mr. Larry Augustine, or any Board member know.
5. Mr. Augustine announced that Ms. Sharon Volpe will handle the Act 48 credit forms. She will submit through PHSSL. Mr. Murray questioned if PHSSL's Act 48 information was up to date. Mr. Augustine said he would check on it.
6. Mr. Augustine announced that immediately following this meeting the packets will be assembled for the tournament.
7. Mr. Augustine announced that Saturday's pairings will appear on the TV screens of Evert Dining Room on Friday during the buffet hours and on the PHSSL Website.

### DIRECTOR'S REPORT

1. Mr. Augustine announced there were five schools in attendance at the State Drama Festival in December. One school could not attend due to their lead actor being in an accident and suffering short term memory loss. The festival was a success.
2. Mr. Augustine announced the 2011-2012 dates for the Drama Festival and the State Tournament: December 11 & 12, and March 23 & 24, respectively.
3. As an informational item, Mr. Augustine gave the financial report (Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss statement depicting the Income and Expenses by month) from July 1, 2010 through March 22, 2011. Mr. Augustine noted that this is the first year with a minor deficit due to equipment purchases for the Radio Announcing event at the tournament. The financial report was approved. Motion: Mr. Long. Second: Ms. Young.
4. Mr. Augustine announced that Mr. Keith Brosious was elected into the Hall of Fame for 2011.
5. Mr. Augustine asked the Board Members to look over the Participation Report and New Member School listing in their handouts.

## OLD BUSINESS

1. Mr. Nailor questioned if Radio Announcing changes were ever formally adopted by the board. Ms. Ursin motioned to establish adoption for this year only and to review at the summer meeting. Motion: Ms. Ursin. Second: Mr. Ringer.

## NEW BUSINESS

1. Mr. Augustine suggested we hold the summer PHSSL Executive Board meeting on Saturday, July 9, with a second day reserved for Sunday, July 10, in Apfelbaum Hall 217, Susquehanna University. Lunch to start at 12pm with the meeting starting immediately after lunch. Members were all in agreement.

## 2011 TOURNAMENT ITEMS

1. Mr. Augustine gave the Executive Board the username and password for the computer lab for PHSSL tab committee members to use while at the tournament, if they need access to the internet.
2. Mr. Nailor questioned the use of online tabbing as opposed to manual tab sheets. Discussion ensued on issue of training tab members who are not comfortable with technology. Mr. Nailor noted that number of tab room workers is too high, would not need as many. Ms. Giuliano suggested only one or two people input the online information. Ms. Young noted that online tabbing was not the issue; disseminating was. Twenty minutes per event to type in the results is too long. Ms. Ursin suggested we keep manual tabbing for 2011, and revisit this item at the summer meeting.
3. Mr. Augustine reminded the Executive Board: "No announcements about events at the high school or elementary school are to be made at the 2:45 PM meeting, as they will be made at the high school or elementary school."
4. Mr. Augustine requested that it be announced at the judges' meeting that all cell phones are to be turned off during rounds.
5. Mr. Augustine reminded all Executive Board Members that the buffet would be held in the Evert Dining Hall between 9:30-11:45 PM.
6. Executive Board members Mr. Murray, Mr. Brosious and Ms. Cawley volunteered to work the Registration Table to collect any changes.
7. Ms. Ursin discussed the merchandise that will be sold at the tournament. No designs were submitted for the design contest, a basic design was used again this year. Merchandise will be set at 9am in Weber Chapel Auditorium.
8. Mr. Augustine pointed out the new Member School Participation report, stating that we have new policy debate teams in Districts 6 & 7. He requested that the board look over the report and if any flaws are found, to contact Ms. Trotta or himself.
9. Mr. Nailor stated that Joy of Tournaments was working well for our tournament needs this year as well as last year.

The combined loss would make it harder for Pennsylvania hospitals to deal with an escalating number of uninsured patients and could result in longer emergency room waits and possibly the closing of smaller hospitals in rural communities. The tax is part of a three-year agreement negotiated during the administration of former Gov. Ed Rendell. It's spelled out in a law, Act 49 of 2010. The Corbett administration says the spending cut can't be avoided.

The National Weather Service confirmed that a tornado was responsible for destroying 30 homes and damaging about 60 more in western Pennsylvania Wednesday night. Meteorologists have been surveying damage in Hempfield Township in Westmoreland County, about 25 miles east of Pittsburgh. Schools there were closed for a second day because of heavy damage from Wednesday afternoon's storms. The storms were part of a far-reaching system that stretched from Nebraska to upstate New York on Wednesday.

In a surprising show of growth, Hispanics accounted for more than half of the U.S. population increase over the last decade, exceeding estimates in most states. Pulled by migration to the Sun Belt, America's population center has edged westward. The Census Bureau will release its first set of national-level findings from the 2010 count on race and migration on Thursday, detailing a decade in which rapid minority growth, an aging white population, and increased suburbanization were the predominant story lines. Geographers estimate that the nation's population center has moved southwest about 30 miles near the village of Plato in Texas County, Missouri. Racial and ethnic minorities are expected to make up an unprecedented 90 percent of the total U.S. growth since 2000, due to immigration and higher birth rates for Latinos. Based on 2010 census data that has been released so far on a state-by-state basis, the number of Hispanics is now at roughly 47 million with figures for New York, Maine and the District of Columbia to be released on Friday. Currently the fastest growing group, Hispanics now comprise 1 in 6 Americans, and among U.S. children, Hispanics are roughly 1 in 4.

The driver of a children's train ride in South Carolina told police he was driving too fast prior to Saturday's accident at an amusement park that left a 6-year-old boy dead and sent 18 people to the hospital. There were 28 passengers on the train when it derailed, including children and adults ranging between the ages of 3 to 54, according to police. Meanwhile, a state inspector came forward Monday to admit that he had falsified the ride's latest safety report, saying he ran the train March 16 when it actually had a dead battery. The inspector was fired. Officials said there was no evidence that the train or the track had been sabotaged.

## RADIO SCRIPT #2

International airstrikes have forced Libyan leader Moammar Gadhafi's forces to withdraw tanks that were being besieging the rebel-held city of Misrata Wednesday. U.S. Navy Admiral Samuel Locklear said Tuesday NATO was "considering all options" in response to reports showing troops were targeting civilians in the city, 125 miles southeast of Tripoli. A doctor in Misrata said the tanks fled shortly after the airstrikes began around midnight, giving the city a much-needed reprieve after more than a week of attacks and a punishing blockade. The city is inaccessible to human rights monitors or journalists. He said the situation was better but still dangerous, with pro-Gadhafi snipers shooting at people from rooftops inside the city.

A spike in radiation levels in Tokyo tap water spurred new fears about food safety Wednesday as black smoke forced another evacuation of workers trying to stabilize Japan's radiation-leaking nuclear plant. Radiation has seeped into vegetables, raw milk, the water supply and seawater since a magnitude-9 quake and killer tsunami crippled the Fukushima Dai-ichi power plant nearly two weeks ago. Broccoli was added to a list of tainted vegetables, and the U.S. and Hong Kong officials announced a block on Japanese dairy and produce imports from the region. The crisis is emerging as the world's most expensive natural disaster on record, likely to cost up to 309 billion dollars, according to a new government estimate. The death toll continued to rise, with more than 9,400 bodies counted and more than 15,600 people listed as missing. Concerns about food safety spread Wednesday to Tokyo after officials said tap water there showed elevated levels of radiation contamination more than twice the recommended limit, posing an immediate threat to infants. Officials say the levels pose no immediate threats to older children or adults.

In Cameroon, Reporters Without Borders is having difficulty determining whether mobile phone operator MTN's Twitter via SMS service has finally been restored after being blocked for about 10 days. After initially blaming a technical problem, MTN admitted that it had blocked the service on orders from the government. Many Tweets yesterday suggested the service had been restored, and when reached by phone, telecommunications minister Jean-Pierre Biyiti Bi Essam confirmed this to Reporters Without Borders, however an MTN representative said that the service is still "interrupted for the time being." While mobile phone service has been interrupted, there have been no issues accessing Twitter via the Internet in Cameroon. The suspension of the service is suspect, as it came shortly after demonstrations against President Paul Biya at the end of February, prompting fears of an attempt by the Cameroonian government to suppress the use of social networks.

Hollywood screen legend Elizabeth Taylor dies of congestive heart failure this morning at age 79. Taylor had been hospitalized for the past six weeks at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles. Taylor appeared in more than 50 films during her career, and won the Oscar in 1960 for her performance in "Butterfield 8" and in 1966 for her role in "Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?" Taylor was noted for her personal life as much as her on-screen work. She was married eight times - twice to actor Richard Burton - and combated many personal issues including substance abuse and eating disorders.

A Texas House committee has passed a bare-bones budget that makes deep cuts to state services over the next two years. The plan approved Wednesday would spend 77.6 billion dollars in state money but underfund public schools by almost 8 billion dollars and leave a 4 billion dollar hole in the state health and human services budget. That's after an agreement to use the state's "Rainy Day" fund that gave legislators an extra \$4 billion to lessen cuts. The partisan vote sends the budget to the House scheduling committee where it will be set for consideration by the full House.

You must have the Certificate of Insurance filed in the State Office before you can attend the Drama Festival and/or the State Tournament. One filing annually will take care of the entire year.
