PENNSYLVANIA HIGH SCHOOL SPEECH LEAGUE

EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING – MARCH 19, 2015

CALL TO ORDER

The Executive Board of the Pennsylvania High School Speech League was called to order at 1:25 PM, on Thursday, March 19 in Meeting Room 2, Degenstein Campus Center, Susquehanna University with the following members present: Lisa Bompiani-Smith, Keith Brosious, Nathan Lawver, Barbara Giuliano, David Long, Sharon Volpe, Kate O'Halloran, Ellen Boyer, Lorinda Krause, Hugh Ringer, Beth Young, Larry Augustine, Executive Director, and Codie Nevil Sauers, Secretary. Michael Nailor was absent during a portion of the meeting due to teaching obligations. Neil Strine was excused from the meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- The minutes of the July 11, 2014, board meeting were reviewed. Motion: Ms. Young Second: Mr. Brosious. Passed unanimously.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Mr. Augustine welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- Telephone numbers were provided for the tournament.
- Mr. Augustine announced that the terms of Ellen Boyer, Keith Brosious, Hugh Ringer and Michael Nailor expire at the end of the 2014-2015 fiscal year. Three Board members agreed to run for another term. Michael Nailor notified the Board that he will not be seeking re-election to the Board this year. An announcement was made that anyone providing a nomination should turn their nomination in to Mr. Augustine by the end of the PHSSL tournament to be included on the ballot for the 2015-2016 Executive Board election.
- Mr. Augustine announced the 2015-2016 dates for the Drama Festival and the State Tournament: December 11 & 12, and April 8 & 9, respectively.
- Carl Grecco was awarded the 2014-2015 NFHS Outstanding Speech, Debate and Theatre Educator Award in our region.
- There will be a change to this year's ballot pick-up and judge's location. All ballots (except debate) will be taken to the lobby in Weber Chapel. The Judge's Lounge and their assignment pick-up and drop-off spot will be in the north lobby area of Weber Chapel.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

- As an informational item, Mr. Augustine gave the financial report (Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss statement depicting the Income and Expenses) from July 1, 2014 through March, 2015. Motion to accept Financial Report made. Motion: Ms. Bompiani-Smith Second: Ms. O'Halloran. Passed unanimously.
- Mr. Augustine noted that there are 142 member schools for 2014-2015.
- Mr. Augustine announced that Ms. Kathy Hewston were elected into the Hall of Fame for 2015. There was a 24% return rate on the ballots sent for Hall of Fame nominations; 68 ballots were sent and 16 returned.

OLD BUSINESS

No old business brought up

NEW BUSINESS

- The date for the July PHSSL Executive Board meeting was discussed, and it was determined to hold the meeting on Wednesday, July 8, beginning at 10:00 am.

2015 TOURNAMENT ITEMS

- Mr. Augustine provided the WIFI passcode for access at the tournament.
- Mr. Augustine asked members to note the change in location of events—locations were changed around to try to allow for longer events to run at the main campus in an effort to finish earlier on Friday evening.
- Mr. Augustine reminded the Executive Board: “No announcements about events at the high school or elementary school are to be made at the 2:45 PM meeting, as they will be made at the high school or elementary school.”
- Mr. Augustine requested that it be announced at the judges’ meeting that all cell phones are to be turned off during rounds.
- Mr. Augustine reminded all Executive Board members that the buffet would be held in the Evert Dining Hall between 9:00-11:45 PM.
- Executive Board members were asked to volunteer to work the Registration Table to collect any changes. Nathan Lawver and Keith Brosious agreed to assist.
- Mr. Augustine reminded everyone to be mindful of the original set-up in rooms that are utilized by university, elementary and high schools. He asked that coaches and judges be reminded of this and furniture be returned to its original location at the end of competitions.
- Mr. Augustine reminded that the announcements at the Selinsgrove schools should be kept to a minimum so competition can get started and finished at a reasonable hour.
- Mr. Augustine announced that Saturday’s pairings will appear on the TV screens in Evert Dining Room on Friday during the buffet hours and on Twitter. Semi-finals will be posted in the same manner. The schematics will also appear in the front of Weber Chapel on Saturday morning.
- Mr. Augustine reminded everyone that the ballots should be brought back to the university for sorting—not to sort them at the elementary and high school.
- An option for a bagged breakfast and lunch buffet were added for Saturday. This is the first year that it is being offered.
- Members were asked to note the schedule changes to Radio Announcing and Parliamentary Debate.

Summer agenda items were noted to be added for the July 8, 2015 Executive Board Meeting:

- Debate events with fewer than 6 entries (lift school constraints at districts)
- Fines levied against judges (possibility of splitting the fee between PHSSL and the judge who picks the event up)

Radio Announcing Round 1 Script

Pictures of nude and apparently unconscious women were posted to a secret Facebook page run by a Penn State fraternity.

State College police say they worked with an informant to search for a Facebook page run by members of the Kappa Rho Delta fraternity titled "2.0" on January 30, according to a search warrant provided to Penn Live on Tuesday.

Police investigated the possible criminal activity in cooperation with the informant who was a member of the social media group and a former member of the fraternity.

The page started about eight months before the informant contacted police, and

On January 18, the informant told police that fraternity members shared photos of unsuspecting victims, drug sales and hazing through the invite-only private page. The page had 144 active members and displayed sexual images, text message discussion screenshots and drugs, including marijuana and some cocaine.

The informant provided police copies of some of the images posted to the page, and the photographs were only a small fraction of the page's post, according to State College police Detective C.L. Weaver.

Some photos included nude females that appeared to be passed out and in sexual positions. According to Weaver, it appears the individuals in the photos are not aware that they had been taken.

State College police Lieutenant Keith Robb said police have the 20 photographs as outlined in the warrant, but officers do not have specific victims or suspects identified.

Police are working with Penn State University officials, the university's Office of Student Conduct and the university Interfraternity Council to continue the investigation.

The Penn State Interfraternity Council has placed Kappa Delta Rho on full chapter suspension.

The Secret Service said Tuesday that an envelope addressed to the White House tentatively tested positive for cyanide after two rounds of analysis. Additional testing will be necessary to confirm the finding.

The letter was received Monday at a facility that screens mail for the White House and is located away from the grounds of the executive mansion.

Initial biological testing came back negative, said agency spokesman Robert Hoback.

Additional testing conducted Tuesday returned a "presumptive positive" for cyanide.

The sample has been taken to another facility for further testing.

The Secret Service, which is responsible for the safety and security of President Obama and his immediate family, said its investigation into the letter was continuing and it will have no additional comment on the matter.

Radio Announcing Round 2 Script

Two men dressed in military garb entered a museum in Tunisia's capital Wednesday, killing eight people and taking several hostages. Ambulances removed people from the Bardo Museum in Tunis as helicopters flew overhead. Some gunfire could be heard, and video showed men and women running away for safety.

Mohamed Ali Aroui, an Interior Ministry spokesman who detailed the deaths at the Tunisian museum, called the attackers Islamists, and the Interior Ministry confirmed there was a hostage situation.

A massive anti-austerity rally in Germany turned violent Wednesday when protesters clashed with police at the opening of the new European Central Bank headquarters.

Frankfurt police used water cannons to disperse protesters after attacks on officers, firefighters, a police station, and the Old Opera House.

At least 94 officers have been wounded, police said. Some suffered injuries when stones were thrown at them, and about 80 were hurt when they were attacked with a substance similar to pepper spray.

Those affected by the substance had respiratory problems and eye irritation and needed treatment. The substance quickly dissipated, and the place where it was discharged was not cordoned off.

The damage included at least seven police cars that were set on fire.

Three people were killed and four others were wounded in a shooting outside a store in Stockton, California, late Tuesday night.

Police didn't say what prompted the gunfire outside the Madison Market, a few blocks from the Stockton Arena. CNN affiliate KCRA said it was a drive-by shooting.

Two women and a man were killed, said Stockton Police spokesman Joseph Silva.

The conditions of the wounded weren't immediately known, but they are expected to survive.

Idaho wildlife officials have retrieved 2,000 dead snow geese that fell from the sky this week. The birds, whose carcasses were collected over the weekend, appear to have died of avian cholera, according to the Idaho Department of Fish and Game.

It's unclear where the geese picked the bacteria from, but authorities are scrambling to ensure that other birds don't feed on the carcasses and spread the disease.

Humans are not considered at high risk of getting the disease, according to U.S. health officials.

Former New York Yankee players Derek Jeter and Hideki Matsui are visiting Japan to support the survivors of the 2011 earthquake and tsunami. Activities include a charity baseball game and baseball clinic.

Participating in the game at Tokyo Dome on Sunday will be a group of student baseball players from the Tohoku region that was devastated by the 2011 disaster that killed over 15,000 people. Profits will go toward helping children in the region.

Jeter and Matsui will also put on a baseball clinic and take part in a home run derby.

Tampa Bay Rays pitcher Alex Cobb has tendinitis in his right forearm and is expected to miss his planned Opening Day start against Baltimore on April sixth. The Rays made the announcement Wednesday, a day after the 27-year-old right-hander was removed after throwing three perfect innings in a 5-3 win over Philadelphia. Cobb had an MRI after the game.

Cobb felt tightness in the bullpen before the game, but his arm loosened once he took the mound. He had been scheduled to pitch four innings.

Jack Haley, who played nine seasons in the NBA, including a reserve role on the Chicago Bulls ' 1996 championship team, has died. He was 51. Haley's family confirmed his death, saying the cause was heart disease. He died Monday at Los Alamitos Medical Center, according to the Orange County coroner's office website. There were no indications of foul play and an autopsy will be performed, the coroner said.

Haley played for the Bulls, New Jersey Nets, Los Angeles Lakers and San Antonio Spurs during his career, when he averaged 3.5 points and 2.7 rebounds mostly as a reserve.

To participate in the PHSSL State Tournament and/or Drama Festival, it is required that participating schools file a Certificate of Insurance listing both Susquehanna University and Selinsgrove School District as additional insured.

To help simplify matters, below is a printed memorandum which you can send to your school's Business Manager. He/she and/or your school's insurance carrier should be familiar with the Certificate of Insurance. One annual filing will take care of the entire year.

Organizations or groups who participate in the PHSSL State Tournament and Drama Festival are required to provide a **Certificate of Insurance listing both Susquehanna University and Selinsgrove School District** as "An Additional Insured." The policy must show that the organization or group is insured for \$300,000 bodily injury, and \$50,000 property damage during the time in which the facilities are being utilized.

The insurance certificate must be received and approved by Susquehanna University. The certificate should be mailed to:

A confirmation of participants or facilities cannot be provided until the Certificate of Insurance is approved by the University.

The Certificate is needed for either or both of the state championships in Drama (December) and Forensics (March).
