JUDGING

All judging will be done via online balloting. Judging assignments will be blasted out 20 minutes before a round is schedule to begin.

All high school coaches/judges must be available for judging the entire tournament. When judges received their assignments they need to move immediately to the assigned room, enter, and push the start button when they are ready to begin the round. At the conclusion of the round, judges need to submit and confirm their ballots as soon as possible. Judges can add comments after they submit their ballots, but they will not be able to change their ranks. Judges are reminded that comments in the “RFD” section are seen by all the contestants, but comments to the individual competitors are visible only to that competitor and his/her coach.

For judges that do not have laptops or tablets, please use your mobile devices to enter the ranks. There are several computer labs that will be open during the tournament for judges use. [Bakeless Rooms 205 & 307, McCormick rooms 2229, 3225, & 3234, & Old Science 237 (Friday only)]

Please remember enter results first, submit, and enter comments later. The tournament will be open until Sunday Evening for comments. If you get stuck, click on the email at the top of the webpage and it will take you to the screen where you can enter comments.

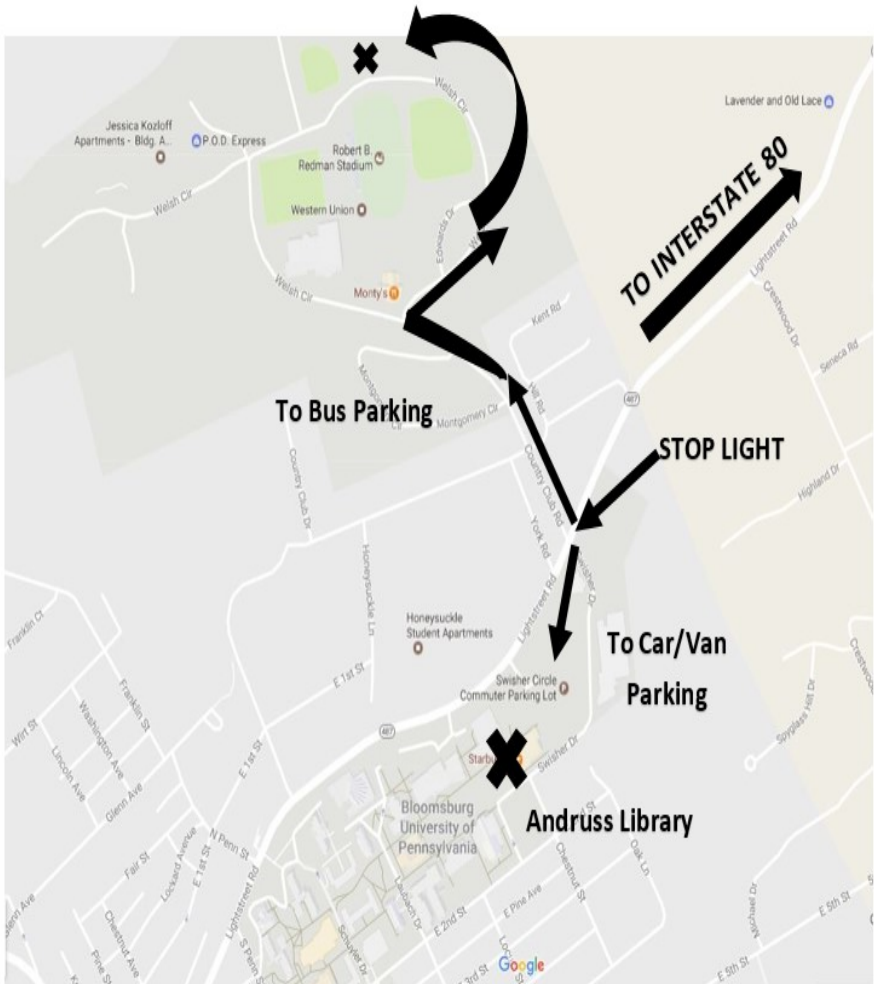
