• Round I, Round II, and Semifinals and Finals(Contestant Choice) – The students will read a three-minute prepared newscast. This script is prepared by the students covering the current events of the time period Sunday two (2) weeks prior to the State Tournament through Round I of the State Tournament.

• Quarterfinals – Fifteen (15) minutes (twenty (20) minutes for Finals) before the contestants are to appear in the round, they shall be given a copy of a radio broadcast script provided by the Executive Director. The script for final round will be different than the one used in Round II.

Fabrication of news stories is prohibited and will result in a student being disqualified from the tournament.

• The students may receive assistance from a pronouncing guide, but may not seek the help of any other person. Failure to abide by this rule will result in disqualification from the tournament.

• In all rounds a 15-second grace period, both under (2:45) and over (3:15) on time is given to all students with no penalty. If a team is 16 to 30 seconds over or under, it cannot place first but may rank 2-7. If a team is more than 30 seconds over or under, it cannot place in the top 7. Students are ranked 1 through 7. All others are ranked 8.

• Any questions regarding rules infringements should be brought to the attention of the Tabulation Room staff and not the student.
